## Prayer Requests:

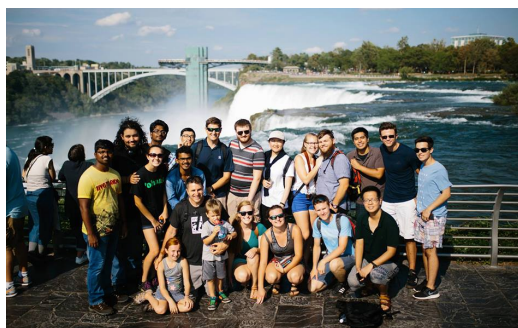
*-Pray with us for 88 students to come to Fall Getaway (Oct 7-9th)*
