Let me introduce you to our guys Bible study at Daemen College (we are actually missing 3 guys here). Although it might seem a bit small, it is actually quite an answer to prayer. Daemen College only has 1800 undergraduate students and 75% of them are women. But the main thing we are praising God for is that 4 guys (mostly in the back of the picture) openly confess that they are not Christian. I was meeting up with one of the guys Tuny who was born in Thailand and he is checking out lots of different religions. I asked him about his necklace with some sort of figure hanging off it and he replied nonchalantly, "Oh this is an idol, but don't

worry it doesn't have any power. It hasn't been worshipped yet." Right now Tuny and 2 other of the non-christian guys, not only go to all of the Cru events throughout the week, but are meeting weekly with Luke (the student in the black shirt next to me). They are discussing a book that looks at the evidence for Jesus and His claims. Please pray for these men that they would believe and trust in the Lord.
