## From Vision to Impact:

### Buffalo Area High School Students Lead Bold Gospel Outreach

Do you recall the chilly start of the year? My kids, Dave and Abigail, along with their friend Hazel, attended a Cru high school conference to get training on reaching their campuses for Christ. Well, Hazel came back and started talking to other high school Christian student leaders in the Buffalo area about doing outreaches on their campuses. Before any adults caught wind of what was going on, the students had already sketched out a week of promotions, and then another week of outreaches. The outreaches would consist of bringing in local pastors to do a talk about the Gospel, and free food would be given out in abundance. I and some church leaders got to lend a hand with planning and some money, but we were blown away by the creativity and heart the students had put in.

It was a blast collaborating with my high school junior daughter, Abigail, who led the outreach week at her school. She's helping run a new Christian Club with a few students. We'd been talking about doing an outreach for a while, and this finally got things going. My favorite day at her school was when Maggie Beedon, a Cru student and graduate of Abigail's high school, shared her incredible story of coming to know Christ personally. By the end of the week, most of the students had heard about the Gospel-centered club. New students came out to check it out, and they even have new people joining every week! There are a bunch more stories from the six high schools, but to keep things short, these stats show what God did that week:

- 13 Outreach Events
- 537 students in outreach event attendance
- 32 indicated decisions to follow Christ for the first time
- 75 indicated decisions to recommit life to Christ
- 600+ New Testaments and/or Gospels of John given out
