After learning some Evangelism skills we would hit the beach and practice what we learned.

That week was huge for Cru Buffalo:

**40 hours of driving, sharing meals together, and 2 am hangouts every night created awesome community!**

People from the same schools and different schools were developing deeper authentic relationships! We truly desire Cru Buffalo to be a community of students that can strengthen each other in their faith then go out and tell others about the hope they have in Christ.

Another result of the week is a developing ownership of our mission among the students. Students received training from some of Cru's most gifted staff and then as they stepped out in faith on that beach in all their weakness and fear they saw God use them. Our students started conversations with drunk college students on the beach and play frisbee with strangers and see God change the conversations to spiritual matters. They also would **go out at night to the local Waffle House and lay out pictures on a table where hungry spring breakers would stop. They would ask what the pictures were all about, and then choose to sit and talk about God.** Besides the obvious practical training and experience, our students came back with a confidence and an excitement for God to use them in big ways on campus.

**This week was a highlight in ministry this year.** We are praying for even more students to go next year. Thank you for your support because through your gifts we were able to scholarship students to go and through your prayers we saw God move!
