Students reach out to Haiti

I'm sure you've followed the devastating news regarding the earthquake that hit Haiti . Many of our **students were asking what can be done to demonstrate the love of Christ** in response to this terrible tragedy. So we knew God was calling us to respond. Obviously praying is crucial as they deal with great loss and devastation around them. Another way we were able to tangibly be involved was to partner with Global Aid Network (GAIN), the relief and development arm of Campus Crusade for Christ. GAIN had containers with 1 million meals in Haiti within a day of the earthquake and eight more containers of food and critically needed supplies ready to go last week. Our students have also rallied together to send over Crisis Care Kits. Each kit is a 2-gallon Ziploc bag that includes essential hygiene items like shampoo, soap, toothbrushes, band aids, towels, and a small toy. We thought we would only give out 50 empty Ziploc bags at our weekly meeting but we quickly ran out of 100. It has been exciting to see the kits come back filled and hear stories of how they are doing this as an outreach in the dorms and coming together as bible studies to fill these bags.
