The other great side effect has been with the ministry at Cuesta Community College. Before when we met at Cal Poly the community college students didn't know where the room was, where to park, and it felt like Cal Poly's thing that they were coming to. Now with the weekly meeting being at a neutral location, that is easy for Cuesta students to get to, we have seen an increase in their students from about 20 last year to 50 students this year.

## Many Changed Lives at Fall Retreat

After 5 long weeks looking towards our big event of the first quarter; "Fall Retreat" weekend October 16<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup>, we headed 2 hours south to Ventura, CA. 515 students joined us, which was up 25% from the last 4 years! We had an excellent speaker, Darrin McWatters, which people from AZ might remember as the lead singer of "Everybody Duck". He gave our students a chance to receive Christ that weekend and **10 students indicated that they received Christ**.
