This spring break I brought 6 students from Buffalo State University to the Middle East to help a Cru Buffalo Graduate student that is starting a Cru ministry there. We got to share the gospel with college students who most had never even met a Christian. Most days we were on campus getting into conversations with students and of course asking them about their spiritual beliefs and letting them know about Jesus. I was surprised by how well most students could speak English, and how friendly and willing to hang out and many were to talk for hours.

I wrote past about Caden a Buffalo State Student that went on spring break with us

last year. During that trip he became a Christian and was sharing his faith with others by the end. So it was incredible this spring break seeing him building into middle eastern men spiritually. They would talk late into the night about deep spiritual life issues. When Caden had to say goodbye to his new friends he made both had tear filled eyes.
