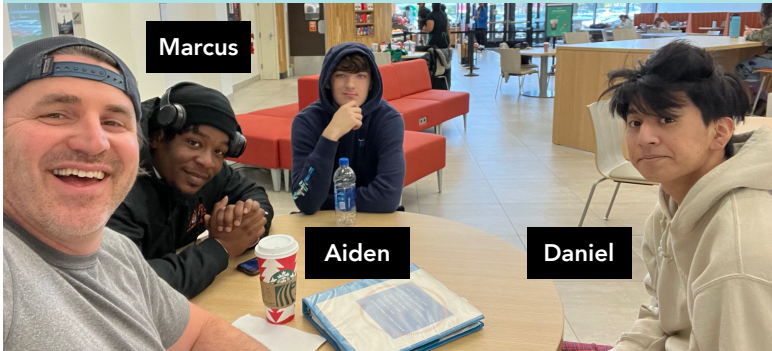


# The Lamb Family
