The Lord allowed us to be involved in two significant meetings since our last letter. One of them was the 23rd annual missions conference at the Bible Baptist Church in National City, California. At that meeting, the church promised \$285,000 for missions in the coming year. This is to be spread out over 143 missionary projects. Space will not allow us to speak of every blessing of the meeting; they were many. One of the highlights was to meet with several other Filipino pastors and listen to the burdens they have for their people. The Lord seems to be opening doors of opportunity for us to work with them. I was also invited to preach at the Bible Baptist Church of Mira Mesa while I was in California. Pastor Willie Dell graciously introduced me to his congregation, which gave \$82,000 to missions last year while meeting in a rented facility. As a result of this meeting, I was able to meet with Christopher and Victoria Hunter, Missionaries to the Philippine Islands. They drove all night to meet with me for breakfast on the last day of my visit. At their pastor's request we were able to complete the necessary papers and invite them to Deputation School in Texas. They did come. They drove all the way from San Diego. They are both graduates of the Bible college which was started by Bob Hughes in the Philippines many years ago. They will be introduced to the GIBF in Indianapolis this month where they will share their sweet testimony.

One couple was visiting in light of signing up as missionaries at a later time. We also had the privilege of having veteran missionary Dave Frauenhofer with us from Hungary. It was an exciting time. Many of the students were eager for the meetings to go longer than three days.
