

We got tested for COVID-19 *twice* before the plane was scheduled to leave. We had our passports in order and the tickets were *paid for in advance*. I even bought a new suit. We stayed two nights in a hotel near the airport waiting to see if the details could be worked out. When we finally got clearance to enter South Korea, it was too late to make the necessary connections to be at the scheduled meeting. So, all was cancelled. Little did we know that a typhoon was to visit South Korea the week following the scheduled meeting. We would have been in country trying to minister to several churches. It could have been a disaster for the hosts to care for us while experiencing a major storm. So, we are thankful for the Lord's deliverance. We have gotten a refund for the tickets and have filed a claim with the travel insurance company for the extra expenses. It is the first time we ever purchased travel insurance. I am glad we took out the coverage. This was the third time Brother Park encouraged us to come to South Korea. Turns out, he still wants us to come in the spring. Our documents are good for 2 years. We will see what the Lord has in mind. We want to thank all of you who have been praying for us and many of you who have helped us financially to prepare for these ministry opportunities.

Meanwhile we are busy ministering to the good folks at North Tiverton Baptist Church, while we are "Standing in the Gap." It appears that the Lord is taking us one step at a time as we wait on His direction. We do ask that you would pray with us as we continue to be a blessing to this congregation.
