The 2008 Deputation School is just around the corner. It will be conducted at the Liberty Baptist Church in Lewisville, TX on August 27th, 28th, and 29th. We give a priority status to our own missionaries and their sending pastors, but there is room available for a few others to participate in the three days of intensive missionary classes. Pastors are encouraged to come to the meetings and bring those who are interested in missions with them. I know you will want to meet these new missionaries and place them on your prayer list as they begin to raise the necessary support to get to their respective fields.

This is not the average, but it was the high attendance for the last year. We are seeing a few souls saved. Recently a teenager was baptized. Several inactive members have returned to the services. There has been a 118% percent increase in the missionary giving and the church is supporting several missionary families. The future looks bright for this church.

My wife and I still count it a great privilege to work with the GIBM. We love to participate in the work and help the missionaries.
