If you follow our email, you already know that we just spent sixty-five nights on the road, visiting seventeen churches and conducting seven missions conferences. We are home now (in Texas) where the weather is always warmer. Recently, we took advantage of the break in our schedule to make some visits to some *pastors* who are on our prayer list.



We visited Pastor and Mrs. Charles Trull of Texarkana, Texas. Last Sunday was his first Sunday back in the pulpit after having surgery to remove cancer from his pancreas in March. The surgery was a success. Brother Trull has lost about fifty lbs. He and his wife are rejoicing over

God's blessing upon his health condition. He is so thankful for the many prayers that have been offered in his behalf.

Then we visited Dennis Fountain who is staying with relatives in Springfield, Missouri. Dennis has been diagnosed with Hodgkins Lymphoma. Dennis said in his most recent email, "I am receiving my 2nd treatment as I type this. All has gone well; ex-



cept for the fact that my white blood cell count is down to 1.1 and that is extremely low." I know he and his wife appreciate all the prayers that have been offered for his health.



On the way home from Springfield, we stopped in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, to visit Pastor and Mrs. L. V. Morris. He is the pastor whose church sent us to Rhode Island in 1975. They have been real mentors for us over the years. They helped us to start and they helped

us to stay. We love them and pray that the Lord will give them many more years of service to Him. Currently we are planning for deputation school in August and our fall agenda. In September and October, we have several meetings with churches in the Northwest portion of our great country. In November, we hope to be able to participate in the final week of the Bible institute in Costa Rica which is conducted by GIBM Missionary Bob Martin. We do not have the funds laid aside for this trip yet. The funds we did have on hand we just spent on car repairs (\$1,300).

We appreciate so much the way the Lord supplies for us through the churches. We want to be a blessing. That is our agenda. You can help us by praying that the Lord will fulfill that desire in us. We are also praying that more of God's servants respond to His call to missionary service. The time is short!
