"Lord, I pray that we would not be overwhelmed by the evil in the world." I listened as the students prayed, heads bowed. "God, would you give us hope by knowing your grace," another student added. As we talked to God I couldn't help but think of how young and vulnerable these students are and how they are being hurled into an unforgiving world. My heart longed to gather them up and protect them from a culture that is increasingly opposed to their beliefs and that seems to be cracking apart at the seams. From their prayers, they obviously sense that. Yet, **God** has overcome the world.

We were at Cru's fall retreat for UMASS, at a morning prayer led by students who were burdened for their peers. Our intention was to inspire these future leaders to rely increasingly on the Lord and not on themselves. One non-Christian Chinese student said she really connected with my testimony about pride and my realization that I wasn't as strong or as able as I thought I was. I pray that she will also follow my example to depend on Christ's transforming grace through faith in Him.

We are not enough in and of ourselves. Even these men and women in the prime of life, energetic, talented... apart from God can do nothing (Jn 15:5), yet with God, all things are possible! (Mt 19:26) Pray with us for the possibilities God can manifest in lives yielded to Him.
