One example of this is our marriage conference, which we held last year as a three-day weekend retreat. Due to covid, we decided to offer the same three-day event online with shorter sessions and at-home assignments. However, we did not have enough registrants to make the event possible. Sadly, strict guiding regulations have not allowed us to offer day trips until now. So, we decided to try hosting one-hour marriage seminars online using the content of our conferences in an abbreviated format. Through the online platform of zoom, we can have people all over the country join, and do not have to limit the size of the group. This is an advantage we had not considered. Moreover, people can attend with or without their spouse, and can choose to attend without video, being totally incognito. For some who are struggling this could have a greater appeal. Our first meeting had about 20 participants from at least 3 states, some of whom were meeting as a small group in a host's home. In this past series about the journey to oneness, we've addressed oneness, hiding vs. being known, and blaming vs. taking responsibility. Tomorrow we will wrap up with control vs freedom. Preparation has been emotionally draining, but Dan and I have loved the sessions, and the feedback has been great. In July we will host a three-week series on communication.
