Pray we have a good turnout and that as we walk by faith [in a different culture and language] God would bless our steps. There are many details still to nail down, but we are excited about this opportunity!

- We also are seeing more students going on summer mission trips than ever in San Diego. The summer before we started, only 1 student went on a summer mission trip. This summer, over 30 are. Pray that many of these students get a vision of how they can use their experience from the summer to help lead when they get back to campus.
