It's also helped our current students feel more comfortable bringing Christ into their everyday lives. This has resulted in 10 of them wanting to lead with us next year and 12 who will go on mission trips this summer. Please join us in praying for all those things!

At UCSD in about 2 weeks we are doing a "Healthy Relationship" seminar. Our goal is to help people develop healthy relationships with parents, friends and boyfriend/girl-

friends. We'll look at having healthy boundaries, barriers to connecting with people well, etc... Our goal is to show them how the Bible speaks into these areas and offer a 2-3 week follow-up Bible study based on the seminar.
