Recently, three of our women leaders went through one of the freshman dorms with a spiritual interest survey. Their prayer was that they would meet some freshman women who would want to be in a new Bible study. They quickly met 3 girls who had had a rough few weeks and were realizing that because of their choices, they were feeling separated from God. Those girls were excited to 'get back on track' with their relationship with God.

I was so proud of our leaders who had initially felt intimidated to knock on doors. Their method was to go through the survey and ask if they could pray for the girls they talked to. God met their act of faith by raising up these new girls.

-- Similarly, at SDSU, our leaders have been planning an event called Project Connect. Basically, our group partners with other clubs, fraternities, sororities and sports team to feed about 100 homeless families Thanksgiving dinner. They partner with local businesses to donate all the food, decorate the courtyard of a local church in downtown San Diego, and prepare and serve the dinner. It has been challenging to organize, but it is such a great way to rub shoulders of other leaders on campus...to bring God glory.
