Though I’ve had the chance to meet with students from many countries, my area of focus here at Disney is Asia. Over the past few months we’ve experienced some spiritual opposition in our attempts to meet and spend time with students from Asia, yet the Lord has continued to surprise us in the way He introduces us to these students! Lucky (an intern with Crusade) had been invited by a



student from East Asia to go on a day trip with several of them and had met Sisi on that trip. They began to talk about God and Sisi mentioned a desire to know more how to grow in a relationship with God. He organized an afternoon for her to meet Julie and I and see where the Lord would lead

our conversation! As we sat to have lunch and began to talk about spiritual things, Julie began to share

her story of how she became a Christian. Julie said “I started to hear Christians talk about Jesus as their Lord and Savior and I had never heard that before.” Sisi responded with wide eyes “I’ve never heard that before.” Though Sisi had gone to a Christian school she had not learned what a personal relationship with God really meant. We asked her if she would want to go through this booklet we have on how to understand what that meant and she eagerly agreed. As we talked about making a personal decision for Christ and explained the 2 circles you see in the picture above, before we even asked her which circle described her she said “Oh, I am the circle on the left.” We talked about this more and then asked her “Which circle best describes you?” She said with a huge smile “The one on the right”. We were slightly confused as she had just so adamantly identified with the person who had never put their faith in Christ. Julie then asked her for clarification “When did you become the one on the right?” She responded with a huge smile again “Right now!”. As we talked through this it became obvious that she had understood everything and had placed her faith in Christ right then, realizing through previous scripture we had talked about how to do that! Last week, she invited me to meet some of her friends and I was able to spend a couple of hours with 6 other East Asian students! How exciting that in the midst of some of the opposition we are experiencing with East Asia that He is still leading us to those who are spiritually hungry!
