But I wanted to trust the Lord to lead me in conversations and be my strength! As I began to talk with Jenny that night she asked me why I chose my job (knowing I worked with this Christian organization). I began to share with her my story of coming to know Jesus and asked her if she understood why Jesus came. She looked at me with wide eyes and said "I don't know much but will you tell me?". For the next hour and a half we talked about God and Jesus, the Lord giving me supernatural energy to step into this conversation! Jenny said she wasn't a Christian but did believe in God and wanted to learn more. Adrienne (my teammate) had already made plans for her and I to meet with Jenny the following Tuesday, so I asked Jenny if when we met we could

share more about why Jesus came. She said she would love that! As Adrienne and I took Jenny out for ice cream that Tuesday and began to go through the gospel again, Jenny was glued to the conversation. When we talked of God's love for her, her eyes were wide as she said "I thought the person who could love me best was myself, I never thought that someone else would want to love me more!" We talked of what it meant to receive Christ as her Savior and asked if she was ready to make that decision. She said she was ready and right there, we got to see Jenny enter into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. I said "Remember how you said you weren't a Christian on Thursday night?" Jenny replied with a huge smile, "I know, now I am! I never thought I would become a Christian in America!"
