We share the gospel with students, teach them to pursue Jesus through His Word, help them have a ministry in college, and challenge them to follow Christ wherever He calls them. We support our seniors as they step out into a range of vocations.

During the last couple months I have been encouraged as I've reconnected with some of our alumni to see them walk with Christ as teacher, engineer, lawyer, businessman, government employee, mom, or dad. I've heard them talk about planting churches, witnessing to colleagues, and wanting to build Christ's Kingdom where they are. Sending our mission-driven graduates to the workplace is significant.

Yet this year more then ever, I've been amazed at how many of our students are graduating from a secular university with plans of seminary and/or some kind of full-time ministry. In fact, would you believe that just this year, 26 of our graduates plan to work with one of the ministries that Campus Crusade has around the world?

The last I heard, seven people have applied to go to Uruguay, where there are only two fulltime and two part-time staff members in the whole country. One married couple has applied to spend their first few years on staff in the Middle East. Others have applied to another closed Muslim country, a communist country in East Asia, and Ghana, Africa.
