9/11 Survivor Outreach

Sujo John was on the 81st floor of Tower 1 when a plane flew into it on Sept 11, 2001. His wife (pregnant with their first child) worked on the 71st floor of Tower 2. We invited Sujo to UW-Whitewater, UW-Madison, and Herzing College to share his compelling story of his survival and his de-



pendence on Christ.

About 1,400 people were captivated by his story. He was able to talk naturally and directly about a relationship with God. At Whitewater, 47 students indicated a first-time decision to trust Christ. At Madison, 17 stu-

dents did.

This was our first event at Herzing College, a small technical institute which apparently has never had a ministry outreach on it. There were about 35 people who attended Sujo John's presentation. From that we found some key people who seem quite motivated to partner with our one student leader to reach out to this college.

Fall Getaway

A couple hundred students joined us for our annual fall retreat. Our main speaker talked about the 40 things that happen to you the moment you become a Christian. It was great positional truth (especially for new believers), good training, and such fun.
