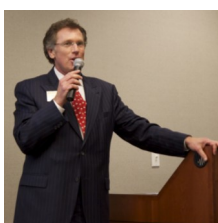




Dear Friend,

I believe all 48 students were challenged that evening, with several saying they would like to know more about Cru or about the spiritual things addressed during the evening. Two even wrote that they were ready to receive Jesus!

The previous week we presented an event called *Badger Pride*. We had a few football players, past and present, who've been involved in our Athletes in Action ministry. They served up some favorite memories playing for the Badgers, answered questions about their faith, and explained what really satisfies them.

Seattle Seahawks safety Chris Maragos talked about NFL players he's observed who have achieved multi-million dollar contracts and are surrounded by prestige and materialistic excess, yet still aren't satisfied. He compared that to his own pursuit of empty things before he finally, as a student, found the fulfillment that can be found in Christ. He finished by explaining Jesus' work on the cross and inviting people to pray along with him to place their faith in Christ. Afterward, 13 people indicated decisions to trust Christ.
