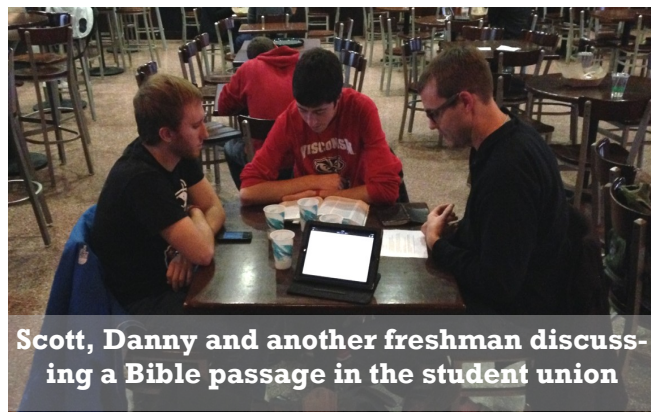


Dear Friend,

God came to me through this group and broke apart my understanding of Christianity, for it was at this point that I first truly understood what Jesus' sacrifice on the cross meant for my life. I didn't have to do a single thing for God's love! As dirty and unrighteous as I was, God wanted to be in MY presence. Soon, I had an opportunity to spend an entire weekend learning about and praising God. I couldn't pass it up! That weekend was the most life-changing event in the course of my existence. It was here that I realized the power contained in a Christian community. I found others who would strengthen me in my faith and make me feel cared about for once. There was absolutely no judgment among these people, contrary to popular misconceptions. It was here that I was truly satisfied for the first time in my entire life. God gave me a confidence that I could not explain. I had no idea what I was missing until this point in my life. I now had a strong desire and hunger to be closer with God, which has not subsided to this day. I knew then and I know now, with 100% certainty, that this was all the work of God. Bringing God into my life was the best decision I ever made, period."

Danny's personal hunger is coupled with a desire to help others know God. This is consistent with so many other students who have come to know Jesus. It reminds me of John, who came to Christ last Winter and just last week led his mother walked his mother through the gospel over the phone using a smart phone app and she prayed to receive Christ.
