\*Ray, a grad student here at OU, shared this with one of my fellow staff members. He and eighteen other OU students headed down to Panama City Beach over spring break to join about 200 other college students to receive intensive evangelism training and experience.

Over the course of the week, the students there engaged in conversation with 1250 people, had gospel presentations with 430 of them, and 108 indicated decisions to trust Jesus as their Lord and Savior!



Just as importantly, students like Ray gained a heart for the lost and got to learn how to share their testimonies of how faith in Jesus has transformed them. Another OU student named \*Jake had this to say about the week:

"Last June, I was in Narcotics and Alcoholics Anonymous and I didn't believe that God could save somebody or use somebody like me. This week, I've shared my testimony with so many people and told them that they weren't too far gone for God to love them. I got to see three people come to Christ. God can still use people no matter where they've
