As I (Clay) have thought about the 2022-23 academic year, there's just been something remarkably different about our movement. We've not just seen growth in numbers throughout the year, but a fervent desire across our movement to know God through his word and through prayer, as well as a passion to share the gospel and reach our campus and world.

No event demonstrates this more than an end of year 24 hour prayer event that was entirely student planned and led. Throughout the event, which started on a Friday at 7pm and went through 7pm on Saturday, there were never less than about 10-12



students in the room, with over 50 total at least coming through! They spent time praying for their summers, their campuses, and the upcoming fall as they seek to reach incoming freshmen.

Some other things to celebrate as the year has come to a close:



We saw around 35 students accept disciple-making challenges! This means that these students will go through specialized leadership training and personal development to learn how to disciple others, lead small group bible studies, and grow in their relationship with Jesus, among other things! We have over 20 students attending a summer mission trip, either in Ocean City, New Jersey or Bratislava, Slovakia. Students in these locations will engage in regular evangelism and intense ministry training to prepare them for either vocational ministry or ministry in their workplaces/churches after graduation.

As a team, we saw nearly 30 students trust Christ this year! Our weekly worship meeting, 180, grew from an average of around 75 last year to about 115-120 this year and stayed that way all year!

Please pray with us and our students throughout the summer. God is on the move here in Southeast Ohio, and while big things have already happened, we all sense that there is far more to come!
