"I wish my boyfriend could have been here," Pia told me (Jordan) between sessions. "When I think about the way we communicate, I realize how much we need this."

Pia was one of the driven, hungry-to-learn students packed into a classroom for our Emotional Intelligence seminar at the University of Ljubljana. Emotional Intelligence (or EQ, a play on IQ), is the concept of developing effective communication skills, emotional control, and self-management to become more effective in relationships, studies, and careers.

Our EQ seminar provides a unique opportunity to connect with passionate and motivated students who may not normally be interested in spiritual things and likely wouldn't come to an explicitly Christian event. However, over two days we get a chance to chat with these students about what they're learning in the sessions and build significant connections with them. We then meet with them for a coaching appointment after the event to help them craft personal development plans.

Through discussing their personal development plans, students often open up about their current struggles and desires to lead more fulfilling, more effective lives. This is when we share with them the only way to a truly eternally significant, satisfying life-through a relationship with Jesus.

In the past, we've seen the majority of participants from an EQ seminar become more spiritually open or interested, and a number have even placed their faith in Christ! It's amazing to see how God uses discussing our meaning and purpose in lifeand what leads to true and lasting change-to open up the doors of people's hearts to Jesus. We're excited to see how He'll work in the hearts of this new group of students to help bring eternal change and transformation through the gospel.
