There's a spiritual darkness that settles over Slovenia. The general apathy of the majority of people here, the complacency with life as it is without God, and the high rates of suicide per capita all further emphasize that heartbreaking reality.

And yet, the Lord is clearly on the move and the light of his glorious grace is shining through the darkness here. We know that the only thing that can change the current spiritual reality here this is God moving, and we know that he often moves through the steadfast prayers of his people.

Our city, Ljubljana, is encircled by a path called The Trail of Remembrance. This trail is where barbed wire once surrounded the city during World War II. The Axis powers used this fence in an attempt to squelch the liberation efforts in the city. Their goal was to keep information from flowing from the city to the resistance efforts in the country side. In a similar way, we know there is a spiritual darkness surrounding the city and country, but we're trusting God can and will break through to soften hearts, open eyes, and bring about transformation to individuals and families, towns and cities, schools and workplaces.

As a team we are trusting God to mobilize the greater body of Christ to be praying for specific people each week in Slovenia.
