This year, like many things, is different. The prayer, planning, and preparation remain in place, but the race has transformed from a sprint into a marathon. The typical involvement fair of students on October 1 won't be happening due to COVID-19 restrictions, and many students will still be taking courses online this fall. That means there are far fewer students in Ljubljana and new challenges for our team.

We are trusting the Lord for new ways of reaching students when we can't physically meet them on campus. I (Jordan) am helping lead our digital efforts to find students who are open to meeting with us-online or in person.

We're excited for the opportunities that this new season has provided for us, which includes reaching not just students who are physically in our city, but also those from around the country. For those who will eventually come to Ljubljana, we hope to be able to meet them in person when they return.

As we seek to reach new students, we're also challenging 13 believing students to form a disciple-making community. Together they will study God's word, pray for each other, and encourage one another to reach the people around them with the message of Jesus. Some of these students are new believers who have never experienced true Christian community before. We pray the Lord would use these 13 students to help transform their families, schools, and communities for Christ.

We can't wait to see what the Lord has in store for this different school year in Slovenia, and we're so grateful to have you standing beside us as we trust him.
