He grew up in a religious family, but Žiga's interest in faith faded during high school. "I felt forced to do things-go to church, say certain things, and act this way. I didn't like that and decided religion wasn't for me," he told me.

Žiga isn't alone in his sentiment. Many Slovene students have become disillusioned with religious acts that don't connect to the heart and aren't centered on Jesus.


He and I studied the Bible together, and each week I could see the Lord was softening his heart and drawing Žiga to himself. Žiga's revelation of God's love for him was a major turning point.

I introduced him to other Slovene guys who are walking with Jesus, giving Žiga the opportunity to see young men who truly love the Lord. He saw that these men don't just claim to be Christians because they are forced, but because of love-the love God first showed us.

Just before we left Slovenia, I asked Žiga how his view of God had changed over the last few months. He said, "God is not the most important thing in my life yet, but he's closer to becoming that."

Please pray that God would become the center of Žiga's life, and that he would trust Jesus as his Lord and Savior.
