We had the opportunity to spend a week in Portland, Oregon to learn about leading our STINT (short-term international) Team in Ljubljana, Slovenia this upcoming school year.

At our Team Leaders Training Conference, we were prepared to succeed in the four L's we focus on for our year abroad: Love the Lord, Love Your Team, Learn a New World and Launch a Movement. The training helped us wrap our minds around the daunting task of continuing to grow a young ministry in Slovenia while walking with the Lord and leading our team.

Currently, our movement in Slovenia has 12 Christians involved. Dozens of other non-believers who are wrestling with the claims of Christ are vitally connected to our community as well. We are trusting that this year God will continue to grow the ministry and help mature young believers in their faith. We're also praying that students will begin to own and lead in the ministry while growing in their desire to reach their peers for Christ.

We spent time learning from seasoned veterans who have led ministries in East Asia, Eastern Europe, and all over the United States. The conference prepared us to resolve team conflict, lead our team into uncharted waters, manage complexity and ambiguity, and trust God for great things.

My (Jordan) temptation is to just go out and try to pioneer things on my own instead of learning from others who have demonstrated the experience, know-how and faith to launch a movement of Christians abroad. I'm certain that the time spent learning from their successes and failures will allow us to hit the ground running when we arrive in Slovenia next month. It's a wonderful blessing to learn from experienced Cru staff who have been in our shoes. We're grateful for those who spent time building into us to prepare us to reach lost students in Ljubljana.
