A week later, she asked if we could meet again. My heart was filled with excitement as I listened to Lauren and watched tears of joy stream down her face. With a new enthusiasm, Lauren shared with me an experience she had while running that morning. "I was just going to keep sleeping but for some reason I felt God telling me to get up and run.' While on the running path, her shoes came untied and she sat down on the bank by the river. Lauren strongly felt God's presence and was overcome by a deep longing for intimacy with Him. "I don't want to lose this feeling," she said. "What can I do to keep growing closer to God?'

Those emotional experiences, while certainly not the foundation of our faith, provide a sense of refreshment and revitalize our Spirit. I encouraged Lauren to think about going on one of Cru's Summer Projects, which are 6 to 10 week mission trips in the United States and across the world. She has since applied and plans on going on a Summer Project to Traverse City, Michigan, where she will be able to spend the summer growing in her relationship with Christ, developing leadership skills, and receiving training in how to tell coworkers, students, and vacationers in Traverse City about the saving love of Jesus Christ.

Lauren is excited to pursue the Lord's plans for her and desires to be a leader in the Greek Bible study, to steward her platform in her sorority in order to reach the lost with the good news of our Savior.
