On October 1, hundreds and hundreds of first-year university students descended on the annual involvement fair in the center of Ljubljana. This event is one of our biggest opportunities to interact with first-year students all at once, and the event only takes place if it doesn't rain.

Just days before the event the forecast appeared gloomy. and we were afraid it would be canceled. Thankfully, the Lord answered our prayers for good weather. Between the involvement fair and meeting students the next day near their dorms, we were able to interact with over 1,000 students!

Enticing students with free energy drinks, we asked if they were willing to fill out a survey indicating their interest in a variety of opportunities we offer students-from how to have a personal relationship with God to personal development opportunities (which often lead to significant gospel conversations) to discussing the deeper topics of life. Of the 1,000 students that filled out a survey, over 600 said they were interested in one of the opportunities we offer! Over the last few weeks our team has been calling these students to set up a time to meet face to face.

I (Jordan) have been so encouraged by many of the guys I have met over the past few weeks and the conversations we've engaged in. I've had the privilege of sharing my story of how Jesus changed my life and also explaining the message of the gospel. The Lord has allowed us to quickly forge genuine relationships with these students in a short period of time.


