Recently I (Jordan) have been using an analogy that resonates deeply with Slovenes. The average follower of Jesus in Slovenia is fighting a tremendous battle in a culture that rarely thinks about God. They are surrounded by people who have no regard for Jesus, yet they are courageously initiating spiritual conversations to help others discover Christ and his love.

It is like being in a boxing match all week long. Seven days a week and 24 hours a day they are being hit, worn down, and pushed to the edge with little rest or encouragement. Our role is to be the trainer in their corner, applying the balm of Jesus to their wounds, strengthening them to step back into the fight, and reminding them that every time they enter the ring God is with them and for them.

Seeing how far Žan has come in the last two years gives us great hope for the future. People like him across Slovenia are beginning to catch a vision for a disciple-making movement that transforms lives, families, workplaces, and communities.

As we look ahead to 2026, our focus remains clear. We want to help believers keep the faith and run the race the Lord has put before them.
