"We'll definitely be back next week," Vasco, an exchange student from Portugal, told me (Jordan) as he and his three Portuguese friends left our kickoff meeting last week. I wasn't expecting that response from an exchange student only studying in Slovenia for a semester, but it's clear God is working in Vasco's heart. The Lord didn't bring him to Ljubljana on accident.

In addition to Vasco, more than 20 other students-Christians and non-Christians, familiar faces and others we met for the first time-joined us to hear how they can have a relationship with Jesus and grow in their faith during college.

Our teammate Melissa explained how the Lord transformed her life and brought her to Slovenia-all in Slovene! It was amazing to see students' faces light up as she shared her story of God's grace in their language. It was a further reminder that learning someone's language opens doors far beyond being able to communicate with them-it can open up hearts to the gospel.

Uroš, a key student leader, shared what our ministry, Vsak Študent (Every Student) offers. He invited the students to our weekly Bible studies and encouraged them to join us for a one-one-one meeting. These meetings provide students a personal opportunity to discuss questions about Jesus and the Bible, and give us a chance to show them why a relationship with God is the most important thing they can focus on.

Finally, a friend and alumnus of our ministry, Matic, shared what it meant for him to have a community of believers helping him walk with God in college. He reminded students that we want to meet them wherever they are on their spiritual journey-whether they identify as Atheists or Christians-we want to help them truly know Jesus.

The school year is just beginning and we're excited to see how God continues to work and move in the lives of students at the University of Ljubljana.
