"Is SpeakOut happening next summer? It's been awesome," one of the 16 high school students attending our one-week English camp, SpeakOut, shared.

As part of our effort to reach all students in Slovenia with the message of Jesus, this year we expanded our scope to reaching high school students. Our teammates Justin and Kaelyn got connected to Jana, a Christian teacher from an evangelical church in town. Jana invited them to teach English classes multiple times at a local high school.

Justin and Kaelyn built relationships with students at the high school as they taught about Biblical principles for everyday life. Students and teachers in the school loved the content, and we were quickly invited to teach in other English classes there as well.

This connection God made through Jana provided us an opportunity to invite these high schoolers to our first summer English camp, which has been incredibly successful in other parts of Eastern Europe.

We've noticed that for many young people who grow up without any Christian background, it often takes months or years for them to come to Christ. By reaching out to them while they are still in high school, we're able to point them to the Lord while they are at a pivotal season in life. We're trusting God will use our SpeakOut English camps as a gateway for the gospel.

During the five-day camp, students have opportunities to improve their conversational English. Each day consists of large group activities, seminars in English, one-on-one tutoring and lots of fun. The theme was "The Hero's Journey: Your Journey" and focused on how our lives tie into God's bigger story of redemption.

On the last day of the camp, our team had an opportunity to share the gospel with every one of the 16 students. Six of them said they were interested in knowing more about what it means to follow Christ, but that they weren't yet ready to surrender their lives to him.

We thank God for this opportunity, and we pray the Lord would continue to reveal himself to these students, so that they would know Jesus, walk with him, and help make disciples.
