Would you take time to pray that God would give Anže a growing desire to connect with other students like him who involved in our movement in Ljubljana?

We believe that God can transform Slovenia and the world through students with hearts for Jesus working together to make disciples in their classes, families, and future occupations. Anže is evidence of God at work, drawing students to himself in Slovenia and giving them the passion and ability to reach others with the gospel.
