Raegan means "regal" and Jane means "Gift from God" or "Jehovah has been gracious." She is a sweet gift to us, and God is indeed gracious. We praise the Lord for a smooth delivery, a healthy baby girl, and for the opportunity and blessing to teach her and model a walk with Jesus.

As we've shared the news with family and friends in the States, as well as with our Slovene friends, we've been overwhelmed at the support near and far. We're excited to see how God uses us as a family of three to influence Slovene students for Christ.
