### Christian Center Choir "Sings Joy!"

Some 1,300 attended three outreach presentations of "Sing Joy", a Christmas musical presented by the Christian Center choir and the Belgian PROM.S choir, December 11. Jeff directed the choir, Kathy designed the poster, Kayleigh danced and sang, Justin lit the Advent Candle for the day, and Nick played a wise man in the children's part.

Missionaries brought vanloads of refugees from centers, Christian Center members who work at the European Union and for the Diplomatic Corps in Brussels invited their colleagues, and others brought friends, family and neighbors. Many non-Christians heard the gospel message presented in song that day. See the quotes below...

"We were there (with) an English couple friend of ours (non-helievers). At work, I met another couple (Portuguese non-helievers) who had attended the afternoon session. They said it was 'sensational'. In our view, the event achieved a highly professional standard and made us proud of Christian Center."

God bless you all in all that you have purposed to do this Christmas in honour of our Majesty, Jesus Christ. I pray that this will ring in the ears of all those who came."



# Out of Africa With EXO

Jeff made two African tours with EXO in September, covering three nations. More than 11,000 attended EXO ministry concerts in Ivory Coast, Congo and the Democratic Republic of Congo (the former "Zaire"). We were amazed at the warmth and receptivity of the Cote D'Ivorians, who were thrilled to see EXO in their country for the first time. In Congo, we ministered in Pointe Noir on the Atlantic ocean and in the interior city of Brazzaville. In the "small miracle" category: the concert in Kinshasha (DRC) was cancelled days before our arrival, but re-organized just 24 hours before we were to minister. Organizers promoted the concert by text messaging and got 500 to the event!



# **EXO Winter Tour Covers French-Speaking Europe**

A winter tour with EXO covered 8 cities in three French-speaking European countries in November-December. Concerts in the Belgian city of Mons; the French cities of Marseille, St. Avold & Fontainebleau; and the Swiss cities of Vevey, Fribourg, Lausanne and Geneva ministered to nearly 2,000 people in venues ranging from small Swiss churches to large concert halls.

During this tour, we previewed new songs for an upcoming album in Ivory Coast including "Akwaba" (which Cote D'Ivorians use to say "welcome"); "Jesus T'Attends" (Jesus Is Waiting for You) and "Regne en L'Univers" (A Universe in Reverse").





Partnering with our IMB friends has been one of the joys of serving in Brussels and we will miss them dearly. Please pray for the Kitchins and Crosses as they move on and for Christian Center as we consider new outreach opportunities.
