The Gospel has challenged me to pursue a personal relationship with God instead of leaving him to Sundays. Lately it has impacted my obedience. I am understanding that obedience is not abstaining from wrong behaviors just because they are bad, but because they keep me from an intimate relationship with God.

Personally, I became a believer during my freshman year. The Gospel has impacted me immensely during college. I was in a place of confusion or loneliness but when God found me, he changed my life. Since I became a believer, I have realized who God is and what Jesus has done for us. I have realized our need for Jesus because he is better and he died for our sins. God has shown me how to love and how to spread that love so others may see the need for Christ as well.

I have seen how knowledge is of little worth without action and that the Gospel invites and expects action. I understand now that the power that raised Christ from the dead is the same power that wakes me up each morning, that gives me strength to go through life, comforts me along the way, and calls me to a greater purpose – being a vessel for His glory, that others might rest in His strength and receive satisfaction in Him.

The gospel has impacted and is still impacting my life in that while my life before college had its troubles, college life has had so many more trying experiences in which the truth of the gospel has helped me. There have been many days at college where the only thing that has kept me going is the truth that I am a sinner saved by the grace of God and loved by Him. The dark places I have found myself in have only made the light of the Gospel shine brighter to me. Things I never struggled with before college have only revealed my further need for His forgiveness and grace.

The Gospel has impacted my life in college tremendously. Coming into college I was sitting on the fence of my faith...meaning I was trying to decide whether to go "all in" for Jesus or back away and have the typical college experience.
