Josh got an awesome opportunity to dialogue about Jesus in front of 180 students. CRU and the Muslim Student Association partnered to host a panel discussion. For an hour we unpacked, "Who is Jesus?" "How is Jesus both God and Man?" "How is your faith expressed in him?" "Why do you personally believe in Him?" What is the significance of the resurrection for your faith?"

I got to share about the narrative of the Bible, Jesus' uniqueness, God's heart for the world, and plan for restoration. I wasn't aware they were going to ask

about our personal experience. Romans 5:1 quickly came to mind. This was a God moment. I was able to share how because believers "have been justified by faith we can have peace with God." And how this peace can create a great confidence and humility to help me obey and follow him.

One Muslim girl asked if I was from Iowa. She thought I looked and sounded like the Batchelor which was worth a good laugh! All in all, it was a rich experience I am really grateful for. May God continue to cultivate fruit from this night!

Men's / Women's Retreat

Last weekend we held both our student men's and women's retreats. The girls met in Wilmington, NC and the guys just outside of Boone, NC in the mountains.

The guys got slow time with each other and God. We enjoyed BBQ, NCAA basketball, and a 6800 sq ft vacation home. It was incredible. One guy shared, "God showed me that He really is better. I felt close and connected to Him all weekend and that filled me with a joy I haven't had in a long time. That will cause me to seek that in my everyday life, not just my mountaintop experiences. Another guy said, "God

showed me I am a part of a community that needs me to play a part in God's plan.

Meanwhile, 150 girls (the most we've ever had!) enjoyed hearing from seniors and staff about how to see God rightly, see ourselves rightly and live rightly. One morning there were breakout sessions with topics such as having healthy relationships, body image and cultivating a heart of rest in the midst of busyness. It was a great time of being together as women, connecting and processing with one another. And of course eating cookie dough too!
