A topic that comes up quite a bit in college ministry is work. It is a source of stress for many juniors and seniors that I personally meet with. "What is God's will for my life?" is at the forefront of many minds at UNC. In light of that, we held a panel for upperclassmen women last week. Represented were a teacher, someone in the technology business, a stay at home mom and a UNC professor. The panel talked through how to discern the passions God has given you, being a Christian in the workplace and how to navigate post-grad life. A big takeaway for students was the importance of remembering our larger calling of loving God, loving others and making disciples. With that broader calling in place as believers, the question of vocation (while still important) feels less consuming.

A great book on this topic is "Every Good Endeavor" by Tim Keller. In it Keller says, "When we say that Christians work from a gospel worldview, it does not mean that they are constantly speaking about Christian teaching in their work. Instead, think of the gospel as a set of glasses through which you look at everything else in the world....the gospel provides a worldview, or story, that provides Christian believers with real guidance for their labor, giving them a deep and layered vision of human flourishing that often enables them to work in ways distinct from those around them."
