## **Spring Break in NYC**

Twenty students committed to use their spring break with us by going to New York City this year on spring break. We spent 5 full days in the city getting to experience as much of the sights sounds and smells as possible. The entire trip is designed to recruit students to NYC for a summer mission trip or for an internship. And it worked!



Four who went with us are returning for the summer, and nine others are going somewhere all over the world with CRU on a summer project.

We had 3 full days of ministry and praying for the city on college campuses and 1 full day to explore the city on our own. One million college students reside in the most influential city in America and the challenges are great to reach them. Long commutes, the financial obstacles, the drive for success make this environment difficult enter, but the needs are so great. UNC joined about 90 others from all over the country who got to bring the hope of the gospel of grace to them. We shared the gospel over 300 times and 8 people trusted Christ. Students were trained with ministry resources and equipped to the strategy to connect students to the movement across the city. It was the first time many of them shared their faith and even initiated a spiritual conversation. Pray for God to continue to work in NYC and in these students.

## **Sending from UNC**

One of the reasons I love being at UNC is for all the potential for the gospel to capture so much creative energy here. In light of all the decisions being made in a persons life, the university is changing the world by sending out a force shaped by its influence. But it's exciting, too, to see the unique callings God has given these seniors. Some will be teaching, some pursuing the medical field, some in business vocations, some heading overseas as full-time missionaries and some continuing in post-grad schooling! Our prayer is that regardless of their callings, all of our seniors will leave ready to impact others in their spheres of influence with the Gospel.

The past few weeks we have had some time to reflect with the seniors we've discipled about what God has done in their lives in college. I (Erin) had two of my girls think back to one word to summarize what they have learned about God in college. One senior, Kelly, shared that her word was "rescue." "I'm just a different person than I was freshman year. The Lord rescued me from so much- really rescued me from myself." Jess, another senior, shared her word was "faithfulness." College had some challenges for her but through it all she was able to grow in trusting Jesus and seeing his faithfulness to her throughout. This is why we do what we do! We pray for the Lord to change college students' lives and it was so cool to spend some time reflecting back with seniors and seeing how He has done just that!

### **Charleston Summer Project**

May 16- June 27 we will be in Charleston, SC helping lead a summer project with CRU. We are excited to have 38 students and 17 staff join us and help transform that city and be transformed by Jesus.
