Something I've learned in my years of college ministry is the first 6 weeks of the semester are always absolutely packed. From training leaders to moving in freshmen to starting up Bible studies, it's a full on sprint! Here's an update of just \*some\* of what God's been doing!

Leadership retreat: The week before classes started, 30 leaders joined our staff team at the beach. We prayed together and planned for the start of the semester. This year we have four student interns, who are seniors that come to our staff meetings and help give input into shaping the ministry. During the retreat they requested time to share their vision of what they want to see God do through Cru at UNC. It was so encouraging to see their initiative and faith!



**Survey tables:** One of the early ways we connect with people is through survey

tables on the first day of class. We give out drinks (iced coffee was a hit this year!) and people can fill out a survey if they want to get connected or talk more about spiritual things. We had 400 people fill this out this year! Many of them have come to our Bible studies and large group. And some have met with our staff and student leaders where we are able to share the Gospel.

We are also having staff help with each freshman study so we can have more of a connection with underclassmen.
