Seeing Lucy come to Christ was definitely a work of God. After having the head knowledge of who Christ was for many years now, Lucy finally came to understand that her heart didn't believe it. The continual process of trying to be the best she could be on her own and having control of everything had brought her to tears at the beginning of our conversation. As we walked through the gospel she began to have a sense of peace by trusting in Him and not herself. Her anxious heart began to let go and let Christ take complete control of her life. Lucy is continuing to grow in her faith with Christ. Together we are learning that experiencing rest in the gospel has less to do with ourselves, but everything to do with Him.

We love that we get to invest in students like Caitlin and Lucy, and see their lives changed by Christ. And we love that you are a part of making this happen with us. We couldn't do this without you.

This winter we are facing some significant needs. In November our staff account entered a deficit for the first time in our time on staff. We've been brought to this point by an expensive summer in Sweden, and continued losses of monthly support. We need \$6000 of one-time gifts to help finish the year well financially.
