Our ministry exists at UNC to provide an environment for students to Encounter and Respond to the God of the Bible. This fall has been a rich season of seeing fruit.

- -10 students (that we know of) have placed their faith in Christ this semester!
- -90 student leaders lead 25 Bible studies every week all across campus
- -300 students come to hear the Bible taught and worship God every Thursday
- -About 600 students involved in CRU Bible studies
- -Over 200 freshman are connected to a meaningful community through our CRU Bible studies in their first semester of college
- -Over 500 International Students from 47 countries have heard the gospel for the first time
- -50 seniors will be sent from UNC with a vision to influence the world for Christ in their calling
- -15 seniors have already applied for a 1-year international mission with CRU

This is amazing when I stop to consider what is happening. We are so grateful for the privilege to serve here and help fulfill the Great Commission. The university is ground zero in shaping our culture and continues to be a launch pad to take the gospel message of Jesus to the ends of the earth.

If you're on the college campus you're on the cutting edge of the culture, you're looking at the culture 15 years from now. [Campus ministry] is our best organic leadership development pipeline...and is one of our biggest assets, not just because we want to reach the campus and college students... But for leadership development, and development of pastors and great lay leaders, it can't be bettered. —Tim Keller
