Here are Thomas' words on how God has worked in his life thru being involved with Cru.

The Gospel has changed me in college. It has shown me the reasons for my struggles with sin, that I have been born into sin, and that though I now live in Christ, I am still in the flesh, and will thus deal with sin until I depart this earth. This has greatly strengthened my fight against lust, anxiety, pride and other temptations. The Gospel has given me a new purpose. When I came to college, I wanted to pursue the American dream. Now, because of the Gospel, the things I did want (prestige, wealth, security) no longer matter as much. What I want to do most in life is simply to be used by God, wherever he places me. The Gospel has given me a real, personal relationship with Christ that has been so wonderful in a new and deeper way for me. I believe it has shown me that the most wonderful thing in life is to know Christ.

We want to share that with you and say thank you for being a part of this story. You have given us the privilege to be here and we could not do this without you! This one student's story (among so many others) is a sweet reminder that the college years are a significant time of life where God can move in unique ways! Nothing makes us more excited than seeing God transform a person's heart. We get to play a small part of that here on a college campus. As an organization we are trusting God to grow the gospel to the ends of the earth.

This summer we get to lead a summer project and invest in 47 students and staff from all over the country. For 6 weeks (10 for students) we will help students grow in their own faith (through Bible study, training in evangelism and one on one discipleship) AND minister to the community of Charleston through partnering with churches there.
