## The Informant: Mark Whitacre

When Matt Damon tells your story in a movie, you have a story to tell. Mark Whitacre worked with the FBI for 3 years as an informant to help bring down a price-fixing scheme in one of the largest food producers in the world. While working closely with the FBI as a whistle blower he embezzled \$9M and ended up having to serve 8 1/2 years in prison. He came to faith while incarcerated and realizing the wreck his selfishness had created for he and his family. His story was made into a 2009 movie, *The Informant*.

A Raleigh businessman has a son who attends here at UNC and scheduled Mark to speak at the Business School as an ethics presentation. That same day he told his story with us at our weekly meeting. He is a great guy and off the charts brilliant. He has 9 different degrees, 3 doctorates and is a lawyer. He works as a consultant

and travels to prisons to tell his story of redemption through Christ.

## A Rabbi, an Imam, and Josh Sat at a Table...

February 21 Josh got the opportunity to be a Christian representative on a panel discussion of the 3 monotheistic faiths alongside a Jew and a Muslim. The theme was Peace and the discussion was rich. There were about 75 students present for the discussion. The gospel was clearly communicated several times and the distinctions could not have been more clear when a student asked at the end, "How does you achieve salvation in your faith?" Put succinctly, "God has come to you in Christ", "I don't know", and "Try really hard were the 3 answers". Pray for relationships and God to pursue those that are lost.
