In Their Own Words: A Heart for the Nations


Jordan Palmer is a junior who Erin has begun investing in this semester. God has grown her heart for the nations and given her a vision to help lead others in his call to the world.

It wasn't until I was sitting across from a Swede in a corner café that this "statistic" became a reality—in form of a person I hardly knew, yet for some strange reason, LOVED. During my time there, the Lord developed my heart for Sweden, specifically university students who told me that they would like to think that there is "something greater out there." As He has caused my desires to grow more in tune with His, I can't help but more fully recognize the urgency for missions — in mobilization of these efforts and in actually getting on a plane to go.
