

## Summary of May

### **\*Hokkaido/OMF trip:**

From May 5-11 we helped an OMF missionary named Richard East start a college ministry in Sapporo. Imagine taking 10 months and cramming it into one week – that's what we did. We prayed, planned, made fliers with the cell phone barcode, decoded campuses, launched a website, shared the gospel, made contacts, had the first weekly meeting, had a mini-outreach and networked with churches in the area.

### **\*Interfiesta Party:**

Student Impact's 12 Tokyo campuses came together for an all-day picnic at Yoyogi Park on May 12 where we ate, played games and explained what Student Impact is about. About 80 freshmen came.
