**A**lthough it appears that the coronavirus is on the retreat, which is good news for starting the new year, challenges and crises remain for many. In our “home



town” of Quito, Ecuador, January 2022 was marked by a massive landslide that took the lives of 23, injured nearly 50 others, and destroyed the homes and property of many families and businesses only about a 10-minute distance from where Tannia’s family resides. The flooding was caused in part by the heaviest rainfall in nearly 20 years and the overdevelopment of the area. The catastrophe is compounded by little government or public assistance options to support those affected. Please keep the many in prayer who are now struggling to recover. Thank you.



**O**nce again, I had the opportunity to facilitate a board of directors strategic development session for the Quesqueya Christian School in Port-au-Prince, Haiti (pictured). They continue to face very challenging obstacles amid the context of the recent presidential assassination (children of whom were students at QCS), another major earthquake, fuel shortages throughout the country, and the resignation of their Head of School (effective the

end of the current school year). As you know, the mission and ministry of this school and what they are committed to accomplishing in perhaps the most difficult setting in the world is a great concern of mine. It has been and continues to be an honor to be associated with them and assist in any way I am able. Thank you for being so supportive. Your financial donations permit me to dedicate time and energy to this project. Your partnership in ministry is greatly valued.
